

Community Support for Findon's 2026 CIL Projects

Dear Findon residents and much valued community groups,

Every year, the **South Downs National Park Authority (SDNPA)** invites applications for **Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) grants** — funding dedicated to supporting projects that enhance and strengthen local communities across the National Park.

In **2025**, Findon Parish Council submitted two CIL applications on behalf of the village:



Proposed Wrought-Iron Village Sign with Planters, A24/High Street/Black Horse. *Inspired by the floral welcome signs in Steyning*



Proposed “Roundhouse” Sheltered Seating for Pond Green - *UK sourced, sustainable timber natural wooden structure with a living roof*



Unfortunately, both applications were unsuccessful in the 2025 funding round. However, the Parish Council believes these projects could still bring real value to Findon — and we are considering resubmitting them for the **2026 SDNPA CIL opportunity**.
